





TITLE: ETHICS AND INTEGRITY IN PHARMACEUTICAL RESEARCH RESOURCE PERSON: K.PARDHASARADHI from DKW College

Date : 24-11-2022

The seminar on "Ethics and Integrity in Pharmaceutical Research" provided a comprehensive exploration of the essential principles and practices required to uphold ethical standards and maintain integrity in pharmaceutical research. The discussion highlighted the significance of adhering to ethical guidelines and the impact of ethical lapses on research outcomes and public trust.

Ethical Principles in Research

The seminar began by outlining the fundamental ethical principles guiding pharmaceutical research. These principles include:

Respect for Persons: Ensuring informed consent is a cornerstone of ethical research. Researchers must provide participants with comprehensive information about the study, including potential risks and benefits, and obtain their voluntary consent.

Beneficence: This principle emphasizes the obligation to maximize benefits and minimize harm to participants. Researchers are tasked with designing studies that enhance the well-being of participants and the potential benefits of the research.

Justice: Researchers must ensure a fair distribution of the research's benefits and burdens. This involves equitable selection of participants and ensuring that vulnerable populations are not exploited.

Challenges and Ethical Dilemmas

Such visits offer firsthand experience of the functioning of pharmaceutical industries and enhance the students' understanding of various processes involved in drug manufacturing. advanced manufacturing facilities and adherence to stringent quality standards, provided an ideal learning environment for the students.

Arrival and Orientation

The students, accompanied by their faculty members, arrived at Maithili Life Sciences early in the morning. They were warmly welcomed by the company's staff and given an overview of the day's schedule. The visit began with an introductory session where the company's history, mission, and core values were discussed. The students were briefed on the importance of good manufacturing practices (GMP) and the role of regulatory bodies in ensuring drug safety and efficacy.

They were shown both wet and dry granulation techniques and understood how the choice of method depends on the properties of the active pharmaceutical ingredient (API) and the desired characteristics of the final product. The granules are then blended to ensure uniform distribution of the API.

The students then moved to the tablet compression section, where the blended granules are compressed into tablets using high-speed rotary presses. They observed the operation of the presses and the importance of parameters such as compression force and machine speed in producing tablets with the required hardness and disintegration time.

Coating and Packaging

The tour concluded with a visit to the coating and packaging departments. The students saw how tablets are coated to improve their appearance, taste, and stability. The coating process involves spraying a solution onto the tablets while they are rotated in a coating pan. Finally, the students observed the packaging process, where the tablets are packed into blister packs or bottles, labeled, and prepared for distribution.

Interaction with Industry Experts

Throughout the tour, the students had the opportunity to interact with industry experts and ask questions. The experts explained the challenges faced during the manufacturing process and the measures taken to overcome them. They also discussed the importance of maintaining hygiene and preventing contamination at every stage of production.

Conclusion

The industrial visit to Maithili Life Sciences Private Limited was an enriching experience for the B. Pharm IV year students. It provided them with valuable insights into the practical aspects of pharmaceutical manufacturing and reinforced their understanding of the theoretical concepts learned in the classroom. The students left with a greater appreciation of the complexities involved in drug formulation and the critical role of quality control in ensuring the safety and efficacy of pharmaceutical products. Such visits are instrumental in preparing future pharmacists for their professional careers and fostering a deeper connection with the industry.







REPORT:

On August 18, 2022, Narayana Pharmacy College hosted an insightful seminar titled "Pharmacokinetics and Pharmacodynamics: Real-World Applications," presented by M. Krishnamurthy. Krishnamurthy emphasized the impact of technological advancements on PK/PD studies. He introduced the audience to modern tools like physiologically-based pharmacokinetic (PBPK) modeling and simulation, which integrate complex biological data to improve the prediction of drug behavior in diverse populations. He also discussed the importance of genetic factors, such as pharmacogenomics, in personalizing drug therapy to enhance therapeutic outcomes and reduce the risk of adverse reactions.

Report on Visit to Vijaya Milk Dairy

Date: 6th July 2022

Objective: To observe and understand the pasteurization technique and temperature level

controls in a dairy farm.

knowledge of the pasteurization process and the associated temperature controls that are

ensuring the safety and quality of milk products.

Introduction to Vijaya Milk Dairy

Pasteurization Process

Key Steps in Pasteurization:

- Receiving and Testing Milk: The raw milk is first received from the farms and tested
 for quality and contaminants. Only milk that passes these tests is allowed to proceed
 to the pasteurization process.
- 2. **Preheating:** The milk is preheated to a lower temperature before pasteurization to remove any air and to prepare it for the next step.
- 3. Pasteurization: The preheated milk is then heated to a temperature of at least 72°C (161°F) for 15 seconds in a high-temperature short time (HTST) pasteurizer. This temperature and time combination is effective in destroying harmful pathogens like Salmonella, E. coli, and Listeria.
- Cooling: After pasteurization, the milk is rapidly cooled to a temperature of 4°C (39°F) to prevent the growth of any remaining microorganisms.
- 5. **Storage:** The pasteurized milk is then stored in sanitized tanks before being packaged for distribution.

Temperature Level Controls

Temperature control is a critical aspect of the pasteurization process and overall milk processing. The students learned about the various stages where temperature control is essential:

- Receiving and Storage: The raw milk is stored at a low temperature to prevent spoilage and bacterial growth before it is processed.
- Preheating: Controlled preheating ensures that the milk reaches the required temperature for effective pasteurization without denaturing the proteins.
- Pasteurization: Precise control of the pasteurization temperature is crucial. The
 equipment used is calibrated regularly to maintain the correct temperature and time
 settings.
- Cooling: Rapid cooling is necessary to prevent the growth of thermophilic bacteria and to maintain the quality of the milk.

• Storage and Distribution: The final product is stored at 4°C or below and transported in refrigerated vehicles to ensure it remains safe for consumption.





REPORT


