Eligibility:

Eligibility for Under Graduate pass in the higher Secondary examination of the (10+2) curriculum (academic stream) prescribed by the Government of Andhra Pradesh or any other examination equivalent there to with minimum of 45% marks (40% marks for OBC/ MBC and SC/ST candidates) in aggregate of subjects- Mathematics, Chemistry Biology (Botany & Zoology).

Eligibility for Post Graduate pass in Bachelor Degree (10+2+4 pattern) in pharmacy program.
